 The candidate should be a BE 3rd year student of Mechanical Engineering and have had no E or F or X grade up to 2nd
 year and having minimum CGPA 7.00 up to 4th semester of his/her study and have family income less than Rs.5.00 lakhs P.A.
- (2) Vinod and Vinay Luthra Family Scholarship 4th year Mechanical

 The candidate should be a BE 4th year student of Mechanical Engineering and have had no E or F or X grade up to 3rd year and having minimum CGPA 7.00 up to 6th semester of his/her study and have family income less than Rs.5.00 lakhs P.A.
- (3) Vinod and Vinay Luthra Family Scholarship 3rd year Civil

 The candidate should be a BE 3rd year student of Civil Engineering and have had no E or F or X grade up to 2nd year and having minimum CGPA 7.00 up to 4th semester of his/her study and have family income less than Rs..5.00 lakhs P.A.
