## IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS FOR CANDIDATES

### I Information Regarding Entrance Examination to be conducted on December 27, 2009.

- i It will be of 3 hours duration (10 AM to 1.00 PM) and shall contain 160 Objective/Multiple choice questions of 1 mark each. 1/4 mark shall be deducted for every wrong answer. There shall be 20 questions of one mark each on the following topics:

- 1 English
- 2 Mathematics
- 3 Physics
- 4 Chemistry
- 5 Solid Mechanics
- 6 Computer Programming
- 7 Electrical and Electronic Science
- 8 Engineering Graphics
- 9 Thermodynamics
- 10 Manufacturing Process

Any four to be opted from S.No 5 to S.No 10

**IMPORTANT NOTE: You are allowed provisionally to appear in the Entrance Test. Your admission shall be confirmed on the satisfaction of eligibility conditions of this test mentioned hereunder at the time of Counselling.**

#### Eligibility:

- 1 She/He should have been student of first semester of first year of BE/BTech programme of a recognised Institute/University during July- December 2009 and have passed 10+2 or equivalent examination from recognized board and have secured at least 60% (55% for SC/ST candidates) marks in aggregate of Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry/Computer science/Biology/Biotechnology.
  - 2 She/He should have appeared in the Entrance Test to be conducted by Thapar University. The cut-off marks in the Entrance test shall be 20% (15% for SC/ST).
  - 3 She/he should be a citizen of India.
  - 4 She/he should bear a good character and satisfy the prescribed requirements of the University.
- ii. In each question, four options(A),(B),(C) and (D) shall be provided. Out of the four given options, only one option is the correct answer. The candidate will be required to write his/her answer indicating one option out of the four options,in the box provided for that question in the answer sheet.
- iii. There is a separate sheet for writing answers. Use only **CAPTIAL** letters for writing the answers (**using Ball Point pen only**) in the space provided on the answer sheet.
- iv. **If a candidate does not wish to attempt a specific question, the space (box) provided on the answer sheet corresponding to that question should be marked 'X'.A box left blank will be considered as wrong answer.**
- v. Space for doing rough work has been provided at the end of the question paper. Use only this space for the purpose.
- vi. **Question Paper is to be returned at the end of the Examination.**

YOU MUST NOT WRITE YOUR ROLL NUMBER ANYWHERE EXCEPT IN THE SPACE PROVIDED.

### II GENERAL INFORMATION

1. The Examination Scheduled for a given date shall not be postponed due to any reason and shall continue uninterrupted according to Schedule even if National/ Public Holiday is declared on any of the dates during the examination.
2. In support of your claim against reserved categories, you must submit the original Certificate, complete in all respects at the time of Counselling, failing which you will be considered only in the open category.
3. The use of Logarithmic tables, Calculators and any other type of electronics instruments is not permitted.
4. No candidate shall be admitted to the Examination Hall after first 15 minutes from the start of examination and not allowed to leave till the examination is over.
5. The candidate must bring the Admit Card to the Examination Hall to secure admission.
6. The candidate should bring his own pen, ruler, pencil etc. and he should not bring any other article such as books, loose sheets etc. into the examination hall.
7. The candidate must write in his own hand with ball point pen only. In no circumstances will he/she be allowed the help of scribe to write answers for him/her. Answers must not be written in pencil. Pencils may, however be used for drawing or rough work.
8. The candidate must write his Roll Numbers (and not his name) and the question paper code in the spaces provided for the purpose on answer sheet. He/she must not write his/her roll number or name or any other irrelevant matter inside his/her question paper-booklet/answer sheet.
9. The candidate should write the answer in the space provided for the purpose.
10. The candidate must attempt question in accordance with the directions on each question paper.
11. No candidate shall copy from the papers of any other candidate nor permit his/her own paper to be copied, nor give nor attempt to give, nor obtain, nor attempt to obtain irregular assistance of any description. Adoption of any kind of unfair means at the time of examination or taking part in an act of impersonation will render the applicant liable for cancellation of his/her claim for admission. Decision of the Centre Superintendent/University Representative/University Authorities will be final.
12. No candidate, shall leave the Examination Hall without prior permission of the Centre Superintendent. No candidate shall be permitted to leave the Examination Hall during the examination hours.
13. The candidate, after finishing his examination shall continue to be seated at his seat and wait until his answer book is collected. **CANDIDATE MUST NOT WRITE OR REVISE HIS/HER ANSWER(S) AFTER THE EXPIRY OF THE ALLOTTED TIME.**
14. Silence must be observed in the Examination Hall.
15. Smoking in the Examination Hall is prohibited.
16. The candidate must abide by such instructions as may be specified on the cover of the QUESTION PAPER/ANSWER SHEETS or any further instructions which may be given by the Centre Superintendent of the examination. If the candidate fails to do so or indulges in disorderly or improper conduct, he/she will render himself/herself liable to expulsion from the examination and/or such other punishment as the University may deem fit to impose.
17. Travelling and other expenses must be borne by the candidates themselves. The University does not make arrangement of boarding and lodging of the candidates.
18. Any change in the postal address is required to be communicated to this office at once.

The candidate should report at the centre of examination at least half an hour before the start of examination.

**Admission Procedure:**

- 1 Only those candidates shall be considered who shall apply on the prescribed application form on or before the last date.
- 2 Admission shall be made on the merit of the Entrance Test to be conducted by Thapar University.
- 3 Candidate is required to pay tuition fee and other dues at the time of admission.
- 4 There will be only one counselling.
- 5 Candidate leaving after taking admission shall be refunded Caution Money and alumni fee only.
- 6 25% seats shall be reserved for SC/ST category and 3% for physically handicapped category. In case, any seat in reserved category remains vacant, the same shall be converted to the General Category.
- 7 Candidate should bring all the documents in original at the time of Counselling.
- 8 In case, a student of first year gets a seat under this scheme then the seat vacated by such candidate shall be offered to other candidates in the merit list.
