ADMISSION NOTICE –‘IN PERSON’ COUNSELLING OF BE/BTECH-2010

Thapar University, Patiala has published three lists for admission to the first year on the basis of criteria mentioned in the Prospectus. Few seats are still vacant after offering admission to candidates through these 3 lists. The University has decided to hold ‘in person’ counselling on August 1, 2010 (Sunday) in the University Auditorium for these seats. Candidates are hereby requested to attend **this counselling IN PERSON alongwith fee & original documents.** *No separate letter for counselling will be sent.*

The candidates on roll (ORC) i.e. who have deposited the full fee and have not withdrawn their seats alongwith the Probable candidates (i.e. CEM, who have not been offered admission so far), shall only be considered in this counselling against the vacant seats for branch upgradation and admission, respectively. **The candidates on roll (ORC) are required to attend this counseling for branch upgradation.** Those ORC, who have got the first preference or have fixed the already allotted branches are not required to attend this counseling.

Important: No upgradation of branch of ORC shall be done, in case, she/he fails to attend ‘In Person’ counselling.

The selected candidates shall be required to deposit total fee at the time of admission during this counselling, failing which his/her candidature shall stand cancelled.

The on roll candidate (ORC) of first year are not required to bring any document except the admission letter on the day of ‘in person’counselling.

Important note: In case, the candidates on roll (ORC) withdraw their admission on or before July 30, 2010, they shall be refunded the balance amount after deduction of Rs 1000/- from the total amount deposited by him/her. The request for withdrawal must be on our prescribed proforma available on our website and must be submitted in original on or before July 30, 2010.
