Terms & Conditions:

- The amount shall be paid as one time scholarship to the student(s) who meet the following criteria mentioned against the respective scholarship. :
 - The student should be of UG 2nd year of the 4 Years Engineering Degree Program of any stream.
 - The candidate with a CGPA of 7 and above and annual family income less than Rs. 10.00 Lakhs will be considered. Income criteria to be followed, No backlog at the time of applying for Scholarship. For continuation, minimum CGPA of 7 with no backlog in any year of the four year engineering degree program.
- The above mentioned scholarships shall be decided on the basis of family income, but satisfying the minimum criteria of CGPA. In case of same family income, the student having more CGPA shall be awarded the scholarship. If the CGPA is also same, then AGPA of the previous year would be considered for the award of scholarship. If AGPA remains same then total marks of previous (two semesters) year will be considered.

- Students applying for scholarship will have to submit all the relevant certificates toward their claim.

- iv) For continuation, minimum CGPA of 7 with no backlog in any year of the four year engineering degree program.
- v) The scholarship shall be decided on the basis of the family income, but satisfying the minimum criteria of CGPA.
- vi) In case of same family income, the student having more CGPA shall be awarded the scholarship. If the CGPA is also same, then AGPA of the previous years would be considered for the award.
- vii) The candidate should not be a recipient of any other scholarship during the year
- viii) The information provided by the applicant for availing the scholarship can be verified by the committee at any point of time. If any information found false, scholarship will be withdrawn and disciplinary action will be taken against the student.
- ix) The right of awarding the scholarship shall lie with the award committee.

Students applying for scholarship will attach the following documents:

- 1) The student has to submit copy of CGPA cards card along with Application form .
- 2) Proof of family income in the form of Income Certificate issued by revenue Official / copies of Income Tax returns for the latest three years filed by the parents.
- 3) The parents shall be required to submit an affidavit of the income from all sources and Has to mention the source of income also.
- 4) A copy of fee receipt paid by the student for current semester.
