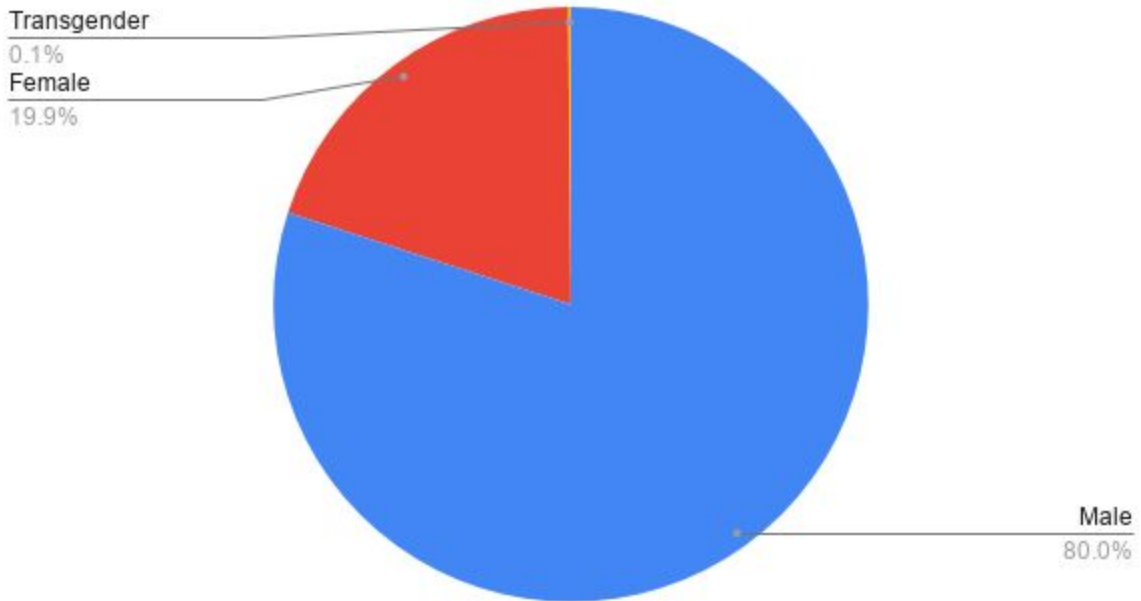
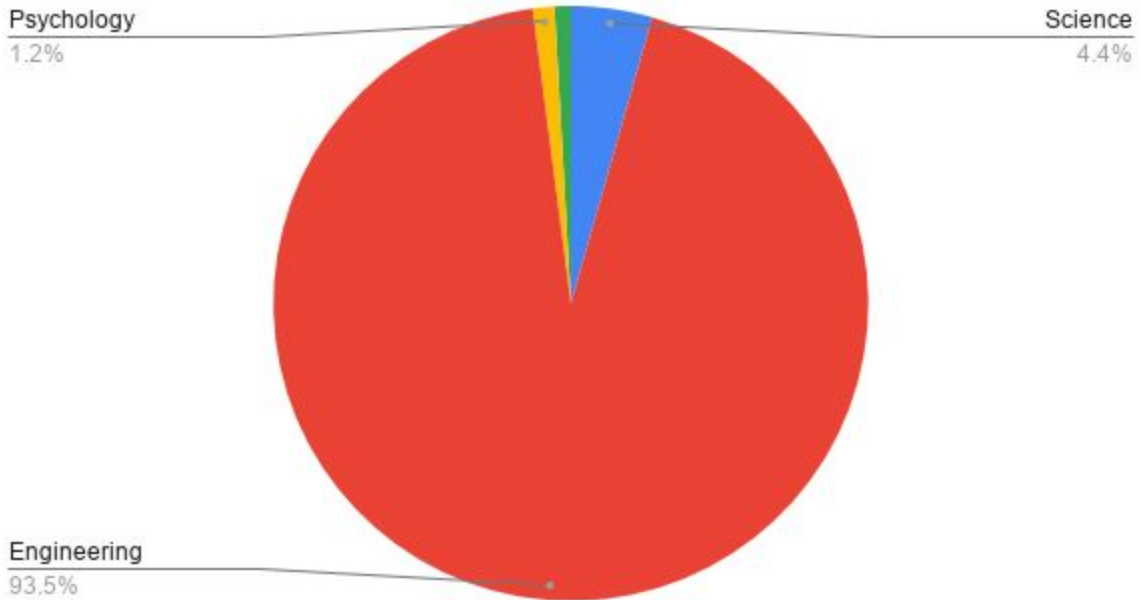

What subject area are you currently pursuing?

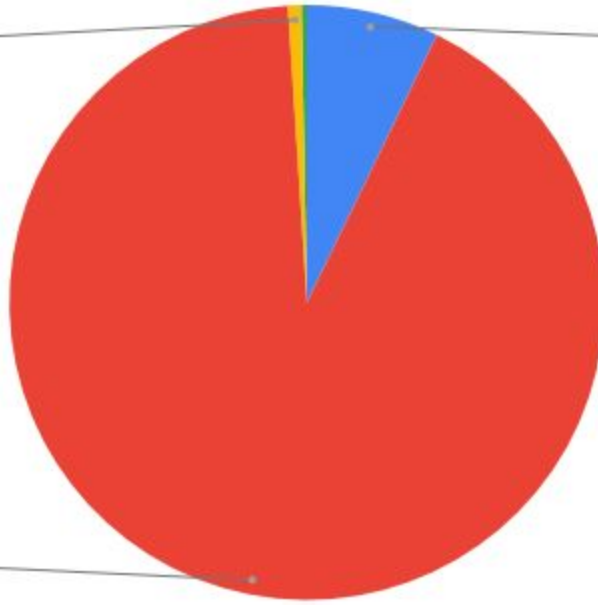


What degree program are you pursuing now?

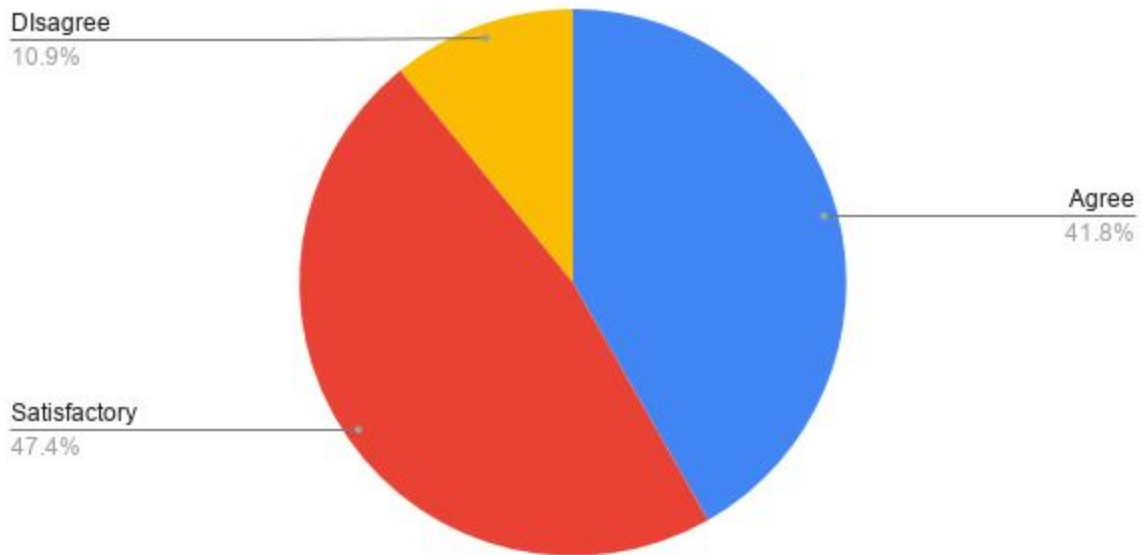

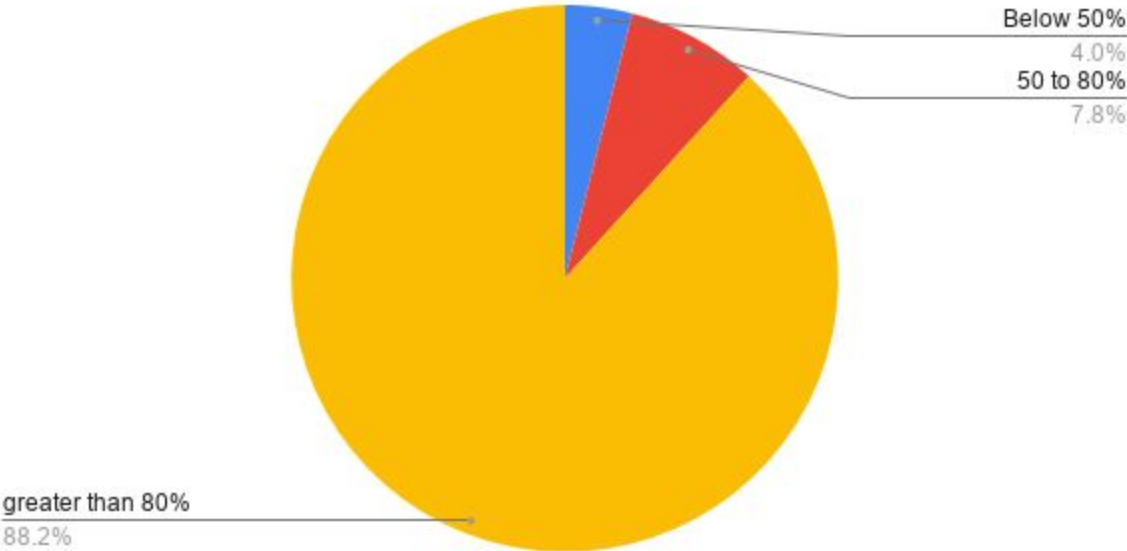
